## ABOUT THE KITCHEN

The new in-fill house blends the charm and history of the neighborhood with all the modern technologies available on the market. Wood veneers, glass, aluminum, and stone blend together with a dramatic splash of visual movement on the island. The fusion of texture and lines creates interest as the eye explores the surfaces. The open floor plan allows unbridled multi-tasking from entertaining for a few or celebrating with many. The kitchen is linked to all the other rooms on this floor.



During the planning stage, each available space was analyzed and put through rigorous thought as to what its function would be in relation to the rest of the space. Each item has its own dedicated space and is clearly defined. Italian-crafted LUBE cabinetry was chosen for the superior quality to investment dollar ratio. The European all-access system provides maximum storage and includes unique features desired.

Cabinetry texture provides a grounded transitional base, combined with contemporary hardware in both a rich tobacco stain as well as a chocolate wenge stain as an anchor. The double-stacked wall cabinets are

flanked on both sides by horizontal windows, allowing the natural light to move across the room. Contemporary hardware finishes the edges of the doors.

The use of materials as well as whimsical shape helped define the island. Sweeping surface curves allow for more guests to gather. The 'leaning nook' allows for someone who prefers not to sit to join in the conversation in a unique application. Island clearances were determined to allow the maximum walk space on all sides.

The Euro clear tempered glass bar top exposes the Russian Sedna granite masterpiece below. The island overhang was minimized in true European fashion to flush with the fronts of the cabinets.

The pantry was designed to store all the stuff a normal walk-in pantry would provide in a classy and smart visual presentation. Each piece was carefully chosen to store and organize the main supplies and dry goods used in the kitchen space.
